

## **ELCIC Scholarship Application**

The Evangelical Lutheran Church in Canada (ELCIC) is the major Canadian representative of the traditions of the Lutheran reformation of the catholic Christian church. Baptized membership is around 94,000 members. The ELCIC came into being in 1986 through the merger of two predecessor bodies.

The ELCIC Scholarship is awarded to a current LCBI student at the Annual Awards Night. The recipient will be a student who has an interest in studying for leadership in ministry or has demonstrated leadership in their home congregation or here at LCBI. The recipient will be an active member of an ELCIC congregation or ELCIC partner church.

Selection of the candidate for these awards shall be made through the selection process of the Scholarship and Bursary Committee at LCBI High School.

- Students in grade 9-11 will have the scholarship amount directed to their fees for the next academic year. Grade 12 graduating students will receive a cheque.
