

LCBI HIGH SCHOOL COURSE SELECTION GUIDE (GRADES 9 – 12)

2025-2026

LCBI High School follows the curriculum established by the Government of Saskatchewan.

- In addition to the required courses, LCBI High School students must take a course in Christian Ethics for each year of their enrollment. CE courses fulfill a P.A.A. (Practical and Applied Arts) or Arts credit. Students need 2 P.A.A. or Arts credits to graduate (they can be at the 10, 20 or 30 level).
- LCBI works within the semester system (aside from our full-year courses of choir and instrumental jazz band). Students are required to take a maximum of ten semester courses throughout the year. At every grade level, there are certain courses students must pass in order to graduate. These courses are known as compulsory courses. Other courses, however, are optional. Students may choose which ones they wish to take in order to fulfill the requirements for their Grade 12 diploma.
- Students may be required to take a full course load. Study Halls will only be granted with parent permission and/or Administrative permission (based on past Study Hall work ethic, etc.)
- Some of the elective courses listed below may not be offered; the exact timetable will be determined by interest and available resources.
- Final schedules will be determined during the first week of classes.
- LCBI will limit Grade 11 and 12 students to no more than one Distance Learning Course per semester at the student's expense. Grade 9 and 10 students are not permitted to do Distance Learning Courses.
